- Remove grass clippings from streets after mowing
- Remove stumps when a tree is taken down

- Pick up litter

### **Notes from the Safety Department...**

- Home Break-ins – This year a number of home break-ins have occurred in Northeastern Jefferson County as reported in the Courier Journal, **but to my knowledge there were none in Barbourmeade.** Several residents have received a recorded phone call warning about break-ins from Metro Police using a reverse 911 system. If you experience a home or car break-in or vandalism PLEASE file a report with Graymoor-Devondale Police Department. You can help prevent these problems with good lighting, by locking your doors and windows and keeping valuables out of sight.

- Do not speed or run stop signs

- Do not impeded traffic when parking on the street and have guests park on one side of the street only

- Please call LG&E if a street light is out

- Have a visible house number

- Graymoor Devondale Police will check your house when you go out of town upon request
