Monday, April 20, 2015

MARCH 2015 MEETING MINUTES

On a motion by Commissioner Crockett, and seconded by Commissioner Ward, the minutes for the March 2015 meeting were approved by a vote of 4-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The financial report for March 2015 was read by City Treasurer Russell. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the financial report. Commissioner Crockett seconded. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

Mayor Coomer presented the warrants for April 2015 (Warrants 04-01 through 04-05). Commissioner Crockett requested to add Warrant 04-06 for Kuhn Gibson & Son in the amount of \$2,100.00.

Mayor Coomer stated he received a number of complaints about snow removal. Terry Gibson explained the most important aspect of snow removal is the timing of when the salt/removal takes place, especially on larger snows like the 11-inch event we experienced in March. Commissioner Crockett and Mayor Coomer questioned the removal efforts on Dinah Court. Commissioner Streit added that he would like to see additional removal efforts at intersections to eliminate the triangle of snow that frequently gets left behind.

Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the ordinances as amended. Commissioner Crockett seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

MAYOR'S REPORT

The Mayor reported that the new website is in the staging phase and should be ready for review within the next week. He also reported that the lights in the Coronado island are up.

SANITATION

ROADS & MAINTENANCE

BEAUTIFICATION

Mayor Coomer presented some information on behalf of Commission Budniak. Commissioner Budniak stated he would be trimming some trees that are interfering with street signs. He also expressed concern about speeding on Hillvale, Pine Ridge and Barbour Lane while KY 22 is closed. Finally, he has received complaints about a mattress in the yard at 3506 Coronado.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Streit reported that there were 80 patrol hours in the city in March. There were two citations and five warnings issued. He also reported that there had been over \$75,700 collected in insurance tax fees.

CITY ENGINEER

City Engineer Ted Trautwein reported on the KY 22 closing. According to information received from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, the failure occurred during the April 3, 2015 rain event when over seven inches of rain fell in the area. The culvert failed and led to the road collapse. KYTC is in the process of designing a solution for the failed culvert and hope to have the road open by September 2015.

CITY ATTORNEY

City Attorney Stan Chauvin stated he has received some additional delinquent tax checks and will be working with City Treasurer Russell on updating the list and possible preparing liens.
