Monday, October 16, 2017

MEETING MINUTES

Minutes from the September 18, 2017 minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve the minutes as received by Commissioner Crockett. Second by Commissioner Longshore. Motion passed by a vote of 3-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Mayor Coomer presented the treasurer's report on behalf of City Treasurer Chris Russell. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the report. Commissioner Crockett seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

Mayor Coomer presented the warrants for October 2017 (Warrant No. 10-01 to No. 10-11). There were no additional bills. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve payment of the warrants. Commissioner Crockett seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Coomer has been questioned about whether chickens are permitted in Barbourmeade. He has not been able to find the ordinance that we believe has been passed. City Attorney Stan Chauvin and City Clerk Brian Davis will review their records and see what available.

Mayor Coomer also asked City Clerk Brian Davis to work on compiling a list of ordinances and minutes from the immediate past.

SANITATION

Commissioner Longshore had received one phone call about large item pickup, and he forwarded the question to Rumpke.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Crockett reported on the downed street sign at Sorrento and Spring Lake. Eagle Sign Company stated they are backed up right now and will get to the sign as soon as possible. Commissioner Crockett said if Eagle can't get to it within a week she may ask someone else to do the reinstallation.

Commissioner Crockett also reported that she has been working on a light that is out on Barbourmeade Road. She will contact LG&E about this.

Commissioner Crockett also stated that the sign replacement/repair project may be put off until next year because Eagle Sign Company is backed up.

She has also contacted the stripping contractor and they will soon be going around the city to look at things that need to be done.

BEAUTIFICATION

Mayor Coomer presented the Beautification report on behalf of Commissioner Tom Budniak, who was not present. The pine tree that was growing into the road on Brownsboro Vista Drive has been trimmed.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

No report.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Trautwein asked the Commission about the paving within the Vista area. He believes it can wait at least another year. Commissioner Longshore said he believes if the potholes can be repaired then the rest of the area can wait a little while longer. Mayor Coomer and Commissioner Longshore stated they would attempt to work on the potholes in the next month.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Chauvin has not heard any updates on the Metro lawsuit.

OLD BUSINESS

City Attorney Chauvin has the new ordinances prepared, but the Commission requested to hold them until the full commission was present to discuss them.
