Monthly City Meeting
Monday, February 17, 2020

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner David Westerman, Commissioner Robert Longshore, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the January 27, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report as of January 31, 2020. The city has collected \$231,866.18 in property taxes so far this fiscal year. This is approximately \$6,000 over budget. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the warrants for February 2020 (Warrant No. 2-1 through 2-5). City Attorney Stan Chauvin submitted a bill of payment Off Duty Ventures Inc. for Code Enforcement in the amount of \$900.00 (Warrant No. 2-6). Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the warrants as amended. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported he believes the recently resurfaced roads are already cracking in some spots. City Engineer Ted Trautwein will inspect some of the spots and determine if a patch is needed.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore has not received any complaints during the recent minor winter weather events. No salt was put down on the streets. Commissioner Longshore has identified some of the stop lines that are starting to fade and show wear and provided a list for City Engineer Trautwein to inspect and possibly repaint. The city will also explore repainting pedestrian walkways and centerlines in spots where needed.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak had nothing to report.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein had nothing to report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin had nothing to report.

OLD BUSINESS

City Attorney Stan Chauvin has developed a plan to address delinquent tax bills. He will be sending letters to those who are delinquent. The older ones will include a date to pay the bill or additional fines will be included. He will include a full report at next month’s meeting.

Commissioner Budniak said we need to make people more aware of the need to register rental properties. City Attorney Chauvin will work with City Clerk Brian Davis to find out what properties have owners who need to be contacted.

The temporary dumpster application should be available on the website. The owner at 7813 Brownsboro Road needs to obtain a permit because the temporary dumpster has been on this site for some time now.

NEW BUSINESS

City Treasurer Russell made the city aware he received a check made out to him instead of the City of Barbourmeade. He made out a check to the city to cover the cost.

The commissioner discussed the tree at the corner of Pine Meadow and Barbour Lane. The vegetation needs to be cut back to allow for proper site distance for cars pulling out. The owner will be contacted.

Patrols in the no parking zone near the school will be increased.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
