Monthly City Meeting
Monday, November 16, 2020

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Robert Longshore, Dan Streit, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the October 19, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for October 31, 2020. This year's property tax bill payments continue to come in. Insurance taxes have also been coming in but appear to be slightly lower than the previous year. Commissioner Streit made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the amended warrants for November 2020 (Warrant 11-01 through 11-05). Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the amended warrants as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported he once again contacted LG&E about the light at Old Gate and Breeland and they stated it would be repaired.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak asked if we wanted to put up the holiday lights. The Commissioners all agreed the lights should be installed. There appears to be an issue with some of the lights at the Vista entrance. Commissioner Budniak will have that looked at when the holiday lights are installed. He expects the lights to be installed around Thanksgiving weekend.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore stated the line painting project has been completed and we are awaiting the final invoice. The lines by the school are yellow (which matches the language on the no parking sign).

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit stated we have not been getting an adequate amount of traffic control, and appear to be shorthanded. Commissioner Streit will be reach out to the chief to discuss this further.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein had nothing to report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported he has been working with Commissioner Budniak and Enforcement Officer David Mudd regarding the signage on Barbour Lane.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Budniak said the city needs a system to register rental property and account for the PODS and dumpsters in the city. This system needs to be developed to enforce the ordinances that were passed so people can be aware of them and know how to come into compliance. City Clerk Brian Davis and City Attorney Chauvin will work together to come up with forms. They will also come up with a strategy to distribute this information.

NEW BUSINESS

City Attorney Chauvin stated he has the original ordinances that he will send to City Clerk Davis.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
