Monthly City Meeting
Monday, December 21, 2020

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Robert Longshore, Dan Streit, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the November 16, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Streit asked for a correction in the Safety & Insurance Report. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the minutes as revised. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for November 30, 2020. The budgeted property taxes collected is already above budget for the year. There are ten people who have not paid the current year taxes so far. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as dictated. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the warrants for December 2020 (Warrant 12-01 through 12-19). Mayor Coomer submitted a bill from James Wright in the amount of \$406.00 for holiday light installation and removal (Warrant 12-20). Commissioner Longshore submitted an invoice from Paving Marking Service in the amount of \$177.00 (Warrant 12-21). Commissioner Westerman made a motion to approve the warrants as dictated and amended. Commissioner Longshore seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer stated he reported a streetlight on Freemont that is not working to LG&E. The light at Old Gate and Breeland that has not been working has been repaired.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman has requested the 2021 recycling schedule from Rumpke.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore stated he has identified two additional street lights that are not working and he will report them to LG&E.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported the holiday lights are on. Two of the units are staying on all day so he will look into the problem there.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit reported that the mayor and treasurer bonds have been updated. Graymoor Devondale wrote one courtesy notice during the last reporting period.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin stated he and Tom have compiled names of places that do dumpster rental. He will compile some information including the city map and ordinance so they can be ahead of the curve when it comes to obtaining dumpster rental permits. He will get with City Clerk Brian Davis to work on the house rental report.

Mayor Coomer administered the oath of office to the commissioners, city treasurer, city clerk, and himself, as their terms will renew on January 1, 2021.
