Monthly City Meeting
Monday, August 17, 2020

Mayor Pro Tempore Rob Longshore began the meeting at 7:30 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Robert Longshore, Dan Streit, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the July 15, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported he has once again received noise complaints regarding the property on Breeland. He will speak with City Attorney Stan Chauvin to see what kind of correspondence was made with the owner after the first complaint was received.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore stated the new signs should be installed within the next week.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported that the irrigation system has been changed to only run on Mondays-Wednesdays-Fridays-Saturdays. He estimates this will save the city approximately \$500 per year.

The downed tree in the drainage easement behind Pipilo has been removed.

Commissioner Budniak said he will contact LG&E about some trees near powerlines.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit reported police patrol has been reduced to 70 hours per week. This change is to balance out the hourly increase (now \$50.00 per hour).

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for July 31, 2020. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the warrants for August 2020 (Warrant 08-01 through 08-07). Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the warrants as presented. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein had nothing to report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin was not present and did not submit a report.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Longshore stated he wants to get the school striping redone to correct the discrepancy between the color listed on the sign and the current striping. He will explore this further and report back to the commission at a future meeting.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Streit made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
