Monthly City Meeting
Monday, September 21, 2020

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Robert Longshore, Dan Streit, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the August 17, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported the city has not issued a stop work order for the house that was doing construction without a permit. City Engineer Ted Trautwein should have copies of the plan for approval tonight. City Attorney Stan Chauvin said the owner stated they had a Louisville Metro building permit, but was not aware there was a Barbourmeade permit required.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had one request for door pickup. That has been scheduled with Rumpke.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore stated the new signs on Brownsboro Vista Drive have been installed. He also met with someone about the restriping project near the school. The lines will be painted yellow instead of white. He should receive the quote soon. He also stated the streetlight at Old Gate and Breeland is not working.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported back on the pine tree at the end of Coronado and Pompano that was in the wires. LG&E recommended trimming the tree and they would go reinspect it. They were contacted towards the end of August.

The dead pine tree on Fox Glove has been removed.

There has been a complaint about a possible business running out of the home at 3404 Barbour Lane. There is a sign in the front yard advertising the business.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit reported 74 hours of patrol in August.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported that a foreclosure at 3602 Breeland has delinquent taxes so he will be submitting paperwork to collect those taxes.

TREASURER’S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer’s report for August 31, 2020. Commissioner Streit made a motion to accept the treasurer’s report as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the amended warrants for September 2020 (Warrant 09-01 through 09-17). Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the amended warrants as presented. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein reported on the building permit requested for the work being done at 7915 Brownsboro Road. City Engineer Trautwein has reviewed the plans and recommends approval of the plans. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the building permit. Commissioner Longshore seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Longshore recommended we move on to a new auditor. City Clerk Russell agreed and that the city now has two years’ worth of audits to complete now. City Clerk Russell will begin the search for a new auditor.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Coomer asked about the Kentucky League of Cities insurance renewal. City Clerk Brian Davis stated he has received several different forms of communication from KLC about the renewal. Commissioner Streit stated he would reach out to get the final invoice so it can be paid immediately.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Streit made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
