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Monthly City Meeting  
Monday, January 24, 2022

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Pro Tem Rob Longshore, Tom Budniak, Dan Streit, David Westerman, City Treasurer Chris Russell, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

#### **MEETING MINUTES**

The minutes from the December 20, 2021 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Streit seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

There wasn't anyone from the public.

#### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the December 2021 report. There is approximately \$1.4 million in the city reserves. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the December 2021 treasurer's report. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

#### **WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the warrants for January 2022 (1-1 to 1-7). The warrant for the snow removal included removing the sales tax since the city is tax exempt. Motion by Commissioner Streit to approve the warrants as read. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

#### **MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Bryan Coomer was not present and did not submit a report.

#### **SANITATION**

Commissioner David Westerman said Pipilo Place was missed last week, so Rumpke came back on the Wednesday to make up for it.

#### **ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS**

Mayor Pro Tem Robert Longshore had nothing to report regarding animals. The streetlight on Breeland has been installed. The streetlight on the Vista island has been repaired. The truck that was subject to the complaint at last month's meeting now has a license plate so it appears to be registered. He picked up a sign that had been knocked over. He will have it reinstalled when the weather permits. He said he may experiment with brine before future snow events, depending on the temperature and whether rain will proceed the snow event. He would like to get the snow removal plans and responsibilities on the city's website.

#### **BEAUTIFICATION**

Commissioner Tom Budniak asked if the Greenscapes contract had been signed. Mayor Pro Tem Longshore said the contract was delivered to Mayor Coomer for his signature.

**SAFETY & INSURANCE**

Commissioner Dan Streit stated Graymoor-Devondale Police patrolled in the city for approximately 75.5 hours in December.

**CITY ENGINEER REPORT**

City Engineer Jon Muscutt said he has had some questions about fences and has been passing along the Metro information for fences. He has also received some phone calls about additions and wants to make sure he has all the information about that before giving them more information.

**CITY ATTORNEY REPORT**

City Attorney Stan Chauvin was not present and did not submit a report.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Commissioner Budniak asked if any of the delinquent taxes have been cleared up. City Attorney Chauvin was not present, so that information will be updated at next month's meeting. City Treasurer Chris Russell said he believes we are down to only five delinquencies.

**NEW BUSINESS**

There was no new business to discuss.

The next regular meeting will be on Monday, February 21, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Streit made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
