Monthly City Meeting
Monday, October 17, 2022

Mayor-Pro Tem Rob Longshore began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Commissioners; Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Dan Streit, City Treasurer, Chris Russell, and City Attorney Stan Chauvin acting as City Clerk.

Others Present: Residents Corey Denbo and Nancy Glasser.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the September 19, 2022, meeting was considered for approval. Motion by Commissioner Budniak to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the Treasurer’s report and financial status of the City for 9/30/22. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the report and commissioner Westerman seconded same. The motion passed unanimously.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the warrants to be paid for October 2022 (Nos 10-01 through 10-08) Attached. An additional warrant numbered 10-09 was added for the payment to Graymoor-Devondale (now Lyndon) for police protection in September 2022, in the amount of \$3480.00. A motion was made by Commissioner Streit to approve the warrants for payment and that motion was seconded by Tom Budniak. The motion passed unanimously. Treasurer Russell also indicated that there was some confusion on tax bills that were mishandled and returned to residents by mistake by the Post Office. Resident Nancy Glasser was advised to mail her tax payment in the enclosed envelope to: City of Barbourmeade, P. O. Box 6525, Louisville, Ky 40206-6525.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident, Corey Denbo raised his concerns relating to the city website and current information relating to city meetings. He also expressed a possible interest in filling the position of City Clerk when the post becomes available.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman said, “all was well this month” and had no further report.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore had nothing to report relating to animals. He further reported that he had sent an email on 9/24 and 10/16 to a resident relating to Barbourmeade Road at Barbour Lane and had not received a response to either email.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported that the brick mason he had anticipated hiring for the repair of the entranceway at Coronado had not responded back and that he was meeting with a different mason on October 18, 2022. He also indicated that the entrance signs at Coronado entrance had been knocked down and will need to be repaired/replaced.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit reported on police coverage within the city and that a speeding citation (54 mph/35mph zone) had been issued on Barbour Lane on 9/21/22. Commissioner Streit indicated that Graymoor-Devondale/Lyndon had billed \$3306.00 for their services in August and \$3480.00 in September, 2022.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported that he is continuing to work on the website organization project and will continue to do so until completed.

OLD BUSINESS

A discussion was held concerning the home and tree at 7907 Circle Crest. Additionally, Commissioner Longshore discussed the possibility of a solar speed sign on Brownsboro Vista along instead of speed bumps and painted lines. The matter was tabled, to be discussed at a future meeting.

NEW BUSINESS


There was no new business to discuss.
