MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the March 22, 2022 and June 20, 2022 meetings were considered for approval. Motion by Commissioner Budniak to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Jon Muscutt said he is making some calls regarding the manholes in the city. He will be seeking quotes from some companies so this problem can be fixed once and for all.

Commissioner Rob Longshore said he has been working with City Engineer Muscutt about a solution to help slow down drivers on Brownsboro Vista Drive. They will explore additional traffic calming solutions and report back next month.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell was not present and did not submit a report for review.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer said he has received a complaint about the condition of the house next to 8104 Spring Lake Court. The Commission will address this later in the meeting.

Commissioner David Westerman said he received a complaint regarding a neighbor leaving their garbage can out for a few days after pickup. He will continue to monitor them to make sure they are bringing in the can in a timely manner.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore had nothing to report.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak said the house that is on Brownsboro Road that backs up to Pompano, which is not in Barbourmeade, has started putting trash cans back on Pompano again. Commissioner Westerman will check with Rumpke to make sure the resident has a contract with them. Commissioner Budniak has also received complaints about the shrubs that are along this property, stating the shrubs extend into the street, making it difficult for two cars to pass without the branches scraping a vehicle.

He is aware there are two dead trees that need to be addressed. Greenscapes will be taking care of these trees when weather permits.

Finally, Commissioner Budniak needs to begin ordering holiday decorations soon. He would like to have a check soon to cover the cost of the new weather-resistant decorations. The Commission agreed to provide a check in the amount of \$3,000 to help front some of those costs.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin has done some work on the organization of materials on the city website. He will contact City Treasurer Russell to make sure tax bills go out in a timely manner. He also needs to publish the budget.

City Attorney Chauvin reported on the situation regarding the house next to 8104 Spring Lake Court. Code Enforcement Officer David Mudd spoke to the son of the owner. They are in the process of getting the roof repaired. The owner's son had been in contact with his neighbor to bring him up to speed on the situation. Mayor Coomer said the neighbor has sent pictures of animals coming in and out of the residence, which he will forward to City Attorney Chauvin.
