Special City Meeting
December 3, 2006

Mayor Holsclaw opened the meeting at 7:01 p.m. at Springdale Presbyterian Church. All Commissioners were present. All City officials except the City Treasurer and City Engineer were present. Guests at the meeting included:

Mayor Holsclaw explained that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss the new ordinance code and turned the meeting over to City Attorney Chauvin. Attorney Chauvin stated that he was unsure whether or not the City could publish ordinances solely on the website, "municipal orders" can be passed and published on the website. City Attorney reviewed and discussed the introduction section in the beginning of the ordinance code. He also explained the "rules of construction" section which is in the introduction of the ordinance code. Commissioner Coomer recommended that the "revivor" section be removed. Attorney Chauvin agreed. A brief discussion was held regarding the section on "Elected Officers" and "Non-Elected Officers" that is in the introduction section of the ordinance code. It was determined that section would be revised. There was also a discussion surrounding the "City Meetings" section and the "Revenue" section that is in the introduction section of the ordinance code. Commissioner Coomer commented about page 28 of the ordinance code and asked whether or not the City's money meets the insurance requirements. Mayor Holsclaw responded and read a section from the auditors report.

Attorney Chauvin preformed the first reading in summary form of the following ordinances:

- Office of City Clerk
- Office of City Engineer
- Office of City Treasurer / Tax Administrator
- Office of City Attorney
- Establishing Regular City Meetings
- Regulation of Construction
- Signage / Destruction of City property
- Dog and Cat Nuisance
- Dog and Cat Leash Law
- The Commission held a discussion regarding the current ordinance. Commissioner Jay stated that she would like to see the ordinance change back to the previous ordinance which stated that boats and trailers were not allowed in the City. The current ordinance allows them if they can not be seen from the street. A lengthy discussion followed. Mr. Heimerdinger and Mr. Collier both spoke regarding their feelings on the ordinance. Commissioner Jay made a motion that the exception in (1)(B) of the current ordinance be excluded and the rest of the ordinance remain the same. Commissioner Crockett seconded. Mayor Holsclaw, Commissioner Crockett, and Commissioner Jay voted yes, Commissioner Streit and Commissioner Coomer voted against. The motion passed. Attorney Chauvin read in summary form the new ordinance for recreational vehicle restrictions

- Failure to Maintain premises

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Holsclaw made a motion to adjourn and Commissioner Coomer seconded the motion. All were in favor. Mayor Holsclaw adjourned the meeting at 10:10 p.m.
