MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the September 17, 2018 meeting were considered. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Crockett seconded the motion. The motion to approve the minutes passed by a vote of 4-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the financial report through September 30, 2018. City tax payments have started coming in and there have been some Homestead exemptions repaid. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the report. Commissioner Crockett seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented Warrant 10-01 through 10-15 for payment. A motion to pay the warrants as submitted was made by Commissioner Crockett. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer read an email from a resident regarding a boat being parked in a driveway. The resident stated the boat was in their driveway because their dock had been flooded and they needed to have the boat at their house temporarily. The boat has since been relocated.

Mayor Coomer read another email from a resident asking for a copy of the temporary dumpster ordinance. The ordinance has not been placed on the city website yet. City Clerk Brian Davis said he will work on uploading that soon.

SANITATION

Commissioner Rob Longshore has had one complaint about a resident whose trash had been missed.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Lisa Crockett has made an inventory of street signs that need to be replaced. She also noted two street lights that are out and one light pole that needs to be painted. She also reported an email on Springlake and a couple on Alpena that need to be addressed before winter.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak said the landscaping work on the Alpena island began today. He also asked the commission for feedback on holiday lights for the upcoming season.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein has submitted the road paving proposals to nine different contractors. The proposal has also been made public. The proposal deadline is the end of January with hopes of completing the work in April.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin was not present and did not submit a report.

OLD BUSINESS

3506 Sorrento will be cited to clean up the property and trim some bushes that are blocking some street signs.

The magnolia tree at 3601 Breeland that is blocking a street light has not been trimmed. Commissioner Longshore said he will trim that tree. He also noted that light is not working so he will report that to LG&E.

There is a trailer that is parked frequently at 7905 Brownsboro Road. Officer Mudd will conduct a site visit to see if he can find it there.

Commissioner Budniak has received a complaint about a large dead tree in the front yard of 3503 Pine Cone Circle. Mayor Coomer will ask City Attorney Chauvin to send a letter.

Metro has done some clean up on the property located at 3417 Hillvale.

Commissioner Dan Streit reported that the children of the owner at the intersection of Pipilo and Brownsboro Vista are going to address the large bush that is at the corner of the property.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Crockett reported a camper on Breeland that has been sitting in the driveway for two months. She has received three phone calls about the camper. There is also a large boat parked in the driveway on a lot on Nandina that needs to be moved. She would like to see a courtesy letter sent to both properties.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Streit stated there was 75 hours of patrol last month. There was one traffic violation and one warning issued as well. They also gave out two parking warnings related to the school no parking zone. Also had one complaint about a barking dog on Springvale.

Commissioner Crockett made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:48 p.m.
