Monday, May 20, 2019

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:02 p.m. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner Dan Streit, Commissioner David Westerman, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell and City engineer Robert Trautwein.

**MEETING MINUTES**

The minutes from the April 15, 2019 meeting were considered. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted, Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

**TREASURER’S REPORT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the financial report ending April 30, 2019. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to accept the treasurer’s report, Commissioner Streit seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

**WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT**

City Treasurer Russell discussed the warrants for May 2019 (Warrant No. 05-01 to 05-06) City engineer Robert Trautwein presented Riverside Paving invoices. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to pay the warrants as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

**MAYOR’S REPORT**

Dinah Ct. had a paving request, but Mayor Coomer replied that is was previously done by itself and would not be paved. Also discussed the house at 3506 Sorrento Ave. is a rental property.

The Rumpke two-year contract was discussed. Commissioner Streit made a motion to accept the contract and Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. Contract was signed by Mayor Coomer.

**BEAUTIFICATION**

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported that he has received several good comments on the street paving. All flowers have now been planted throughout the neighborhood. The issue of rental properties continues and there none are registered. Appears to be sticks being piled up in the island at Coronado Dr. Cost \$175.00 to clean up (again)

Also discussed the power outage on Nandina Dr. Lost power on 5/19 at 4:30 PM and did not come back on until 4:30 AM the following morning. Commissioner Streit is checking on a good contact to discuss the issue with LG&E.

**SAFETY & INSURANCE**

Commissioner Dan Streit discussed insurance cost and stated it is right on budget. April had two patrols incidents. One citation and one warning.

**CITY ENGINEER REPORT**

City Engineer Ted Trautwein presented cost of restriping at stop signs where the streets were paved. There are several options (bar only, bar and "STOP" etc.) Better paint is available at additional cost. Ted Trautwein and Stan Chauvin to check on DOT requirements.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Bush at corner of Pipilo has now been trimmed.


**ANNUAL BUDGET**

The annual budget worksheet was completed and first reading done.


Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
