Monthly City Meeting
Monday, July 15, 2019

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner David Westerman, Commissioner Robert Longshore (7:01 p.m.), City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the June 17, 2019 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell reviewed the Statement of Assets, Liabilities and Capital for June 30, 2019. He also conducted an overview of budgeted items from FY 2019. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to approve the financial reports. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell reviewed the warrants for July 2019 (07-01 through 07-07). Commissioner Rob Longshore asked to hold on Warrant 07-07 in regards to the Reach Alert program. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to pay the warrants. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer had nothing to report.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Rob Longshore stated he has the estimate for sign replacement/repairs but he will be going through to make sure everything is covered. This estimate was provided by Eagle Sign Company. He will go around and see what items need to be completed and will initiate the contract as amended.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak presented a back flow valve report from the recent testing. He would like to put an item in the newsletter about the city needing a handyman as the person who has been used has moved away. This item will be included in the upcoming newsletter.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein conducted a study of the stop signs in the city. There are about 36 stop signs. A stop bar is \$175.00 each, and the words STOP adds another \$225.00. Commissioner Longshore feels the painting needs to be updated in all areas, not just the recently paved areas. He would prefer to just do the stop bar and not add the word STOP, as he has received comments from residents saying they do not like STOP on the pavement. City Engineer Trautwein likes this as well. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to only do the stop bars throughout the city. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

Commissioner Westerman reported there are a couple manholes in the recently paved section of Brownsboro Vista that are loose and make noise when stepped/drove on. He will get an address and send that to City Trautwein so that is can be repaired.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported he is working on a number of tax liens, and he thinks it would be a good ideas to bill for the outstanding taxes on the new tax bills that are about to go out.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Budniak stated the container at 3509 Nandina is still there. City Attorney Chauvin said he gave that to the enforcement officer but will follow up to see if contact was made with the owner/occupant.

Also, realtor signs are still being placed in the right-of-way and being left beyond open house hours.

Commissioner Budniak reported that the overgrown tree at 7807 Pine Meadows Lane has not been trimmed. It needs to be addressed soon as it restricts vision at the intersection at Pine Meadows Lane and Barbour Lane.

Michael Brown presented the building permit approved by Louisville Metro Construction Review for the proposed garage at 3511 Barbour Lane. He explained the lots have been consolidated and the building meets all requirements for Louisville Metro. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the building permit. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote 3-0-1 (Commissioner Budniak abstained).

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to discuss.

Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
