Monthly City Meeting
Monday, January 27, 2020

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner David Westerman, Commissioner Robert Longshore, City Treasurer Chris Russell, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the December 16, 2019 meeting were not ready so no vote was taken.

The minutes from the September 16, 2019 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the minutes as amended (replace Pine Meadows with Nandina, and replace Brownsboro Vista with Foxglove). Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report as of December 31, 2019. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the warrants for payment for January 2020 (Warrants 01-01 through 01-06). Commissioner Budniak presented a request for payment in the amount of \$100.00 for holiday gift reimbursement (01-07). Commissioner Budniak also made a request for payment in the amount of \$55.82 for holiday decoration supplies (01-08). Commissioner Longshore requested payment to Eagle Sign in the amount of \$12,864.24 (01-09) for the sign repair and replacement project. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to pay the warrants as amended. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported he received a complaint from the owner of 7901 Brownsboro Road that a portion of the access road needs to be repaired. Commissioner Longshore has visited the site and has pictures to document the situation. The area will be monitored.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman reported he had one complaint about missed recycling pickup.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore said he will be looking at areas where the pavement needs to be painted/retouched. He is also monitoring the manhole covers that need to be properly installed as a result of the recent pavement work.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak presented a new contract from Greenscapes to continue maintenance on the city properties. The contract is for the same amount as previous years. Commissioner Budniak provided an overview of the amount and type of work to be completed as part of the contract. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to accept the contract as presented. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

Commissioner Budniak reported there needs to be some work on the tree at the intersection of Barbour Lane and Pine Meadows Lane. The tree limits site distance.

Mayor Coomer stated one of the road work signs on KY 22 needs to be relocated because it too limits site distance at the intersection of KY 22 and Brownsboro Vista.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Budniak had a question about the delinquent tax list. He stated one of the properties has transferred and asked if the city done what needs to be done to collect the delinquent tax money.

Commissioner Budniak asked what measures have been taken regarding the ordinance about rental property registration and temporary dumpsters. This item will be discussed next meeting when City Attorney Chauvin is in attendance.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Westerman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
