Monthly City Meeting
Monday, October 21, 2019

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner David Westerman, Commissioner Robert Longshore, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the September 16, 2019 were not ready so no vote was taken.

TREASURER’S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the statement of assets, liabilities, and capital as well as the statement of income and expenses through September 30, 2019. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to accept the treasurer’s report. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented Warrants 10-01 through 10-12. City Engineer Ted Trautwein provided a bill from Riverside Paving in the amount of \$9,625.00 for the striping work done on the roads. Mayor Coomer stated the manhole repairs have not been made and he does not think the city should pay the entire amount until that work is completed. Commissioner Robert Longshore recommended holding back \$3,000 from the bill. Warrant 10-13 in the amount of \$6,625 to Riverside was added. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to pay the warrants as amended. Second by Commissioner Longshore. The vote passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR’S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer stated he had received a complaint about receiving a second tax bill when she knows she had already paid it. City Treasurer Russell took the owner’s information and will reach out to them.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Rob Longshore reported the sign project is still underway. The signs are being removed, repainted and refurbished, and then reinstalled. He anticipates the work will be completed within the next month.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak received a complaint about the temporary trailer on the fire property. City Attorney Stan Chauvin will follow up on the issue.

Commissioner Budniak also received a request to have flag poles with flags installed at the entrances to the subdivision. The commissioners discussed the item and determined it would be difficult to properly maintain and open up other requests that would put an unnecessary burden on the city.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein had nothing to report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin has some items he is working on with Code Enforcement Officer David Mudd. Mr. Mudd is out of town and unable to attend tonight's meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Longshore asked if some of the temporary containers located in the city had been addressed. One has been removed and the other is OK.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Coomer stated there is a vehicle that is parking at the end of the south end of the Brownsboro Vista island that could impede the flow of traffic.

Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
