Monthly City Meeting
Monday, October 19, 2020

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, David Westerman, Robert Longshore, Dan Streit, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Engineer Ted Trautwein, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the September 21, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for September 30, 2020. This year's property tax bill payments have started coming in. Commissioner Streit made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Russell presented the amended warrants for October 2020 (Warrant 10-01 through 10-10). Commissioner Streit corrected the amount for the Graymoor-Devondale Police payment, Warrant 10-02, to the amount of \$3,422.50. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the amended warrants as amended. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported he has received a request for speed humps. The commissioners discussed the idea and were not in favor of installing them at this time. He also received an inquiry about a potential eight foot high fence. According to the Louisville Metro Land Development Code you can have an eight foot tall fence in a rear yard.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman had a request to see if Rumpke offered larger dumpsters. He will follow up with Rumpke to see if that is an option or if someone can request two dumpsters.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore stated the line painting project should be completed in the near future once weather cooperates.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported this month's Greenscape's payment is a consolidation of three different bills for service. This includes fall flower plantings as well as some island renovations.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Dan Streit reported the liability insurance through the Kentucky League of Cities has been renewed. He did not receive an update from Graymoor Devondale Police.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Ted Trautwein received one check for a building permit. He had nothing else to report.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported he has been working with Code Enforcement Officer David Mudd regarding some enforcement matters.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Longshore made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
