Monthly City Meeting  
Monday, May 18, 2020

Mayor Coomer began the meeting at 7:03 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website and the Nextdoor platform. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner Dan Streit, Commissioner David Westerman, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, and City Clerk Brian Davis.

#### **MEETING MINUTES**

The minutes from the April 20, 2020 meeting were considered for approval. Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

#### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report as of April 30, 2020. The city has approximately \$1.2 million in reserves. Commissioner Streit made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Westerman seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

#### **WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT**

City Treasurer Russell presented the warrants for May 2020 (Warrant No. 05-01 through 05-05). Commissioner Streit made a motion to approve the warrants as presented. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

There were no public comments.

#### **MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Bryan Coomer reported that the budget review was not possible tonight due to the meeting circumstances. He said he will send out a budget worksheet and there will be an additional special meeting in June to make sure the budget gets approved properly.

#### **SANITATION**

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

#### **ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS**

Commissioner Robert Longshore was not present and did not submit a report.

#### **BEAUTIFICATION**

Commissioner Tom Budniak asked Commissioner Streit to contact the police department about increasing patrols along Barbour Lane because of the Wolf Pen Branch Road closing. This project is scheduled to last until August and there has been a significant increase in traffic from Brownsboro Road.

#### **SAFETY & INSURANCE**

Commissioner Dan Streit reported that police patrolled 72 hours last month.

**CITY ENGINEER REPORT**

City Engineer Ted Trautwein was not in attendance and did not submit a report.

**CITY ATTORNEY REPORT**

City Attorney Stan Chauvin informed the commissioners that the election filing deadline is approaching and they should contact the county clerk's office for more information. He has the delinquent tax letters ready but has been hesitant to send them out during this period. Mr. Chauvin is waiting on a response from David Mudd about his visit to the home with the dumpster.

**OLD BUSINESS**

There was no old business.

**NEW BUSINESS**

City Treasurer Chris Russell said he has had problems contacting the auditor for this past fiscal year. City Clerk Brian Davis stated he has filed an extension with the state to have more time to submit this document for review. It may a good idea to explore finding another auditor after this year. City Attorney Chauvin said some cities are considering different tax alternatives and this may be something to consider for the budget.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Budniak made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Streit seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
