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Monthly City Meeting  
Monday, July 20, 2020

Mayor Pro Tempore Rob Longshore began the meeting at 7:07 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer (7:10 p.m.), Commissioner Tom Budniak, Commissioner David Westerman, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Engineer Ted Trautwein (7:15 p.m.), and City Clerk Brian Davis.

### **MEETING MINUTES**

The minutes from the June 15, 2020 and June 17, 2020 meetings were considered for approval. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0 (Commissioner Budniak did not vote).

### **WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT**

City Clerk Brian Davis presented the warrants as submitted by City Treasurer Chris Russell for July 2020 (Warrant 07-01 through 07-05). Commissioner Longshore made a motion to approve the warrants as presented. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0 (Commissioner Budniak did not vote).

### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

Commissioner Longshore presented the treasurer's report as submitted by City Treasurer Chris Russell for June 30, 2020. Commissioner Westerman made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as submitted. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0 (Commissioner Budniak did not vote).

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

There were no public comments.

### **MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Bryan Coomer will report during the old and new business items.

### **SANITATION**

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

### **ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS**

Commissioner Robert Longshore has ordered two new 25 mph speed limit signs for Brownsboro Vista Drive. They should be received within the next month.

### **SAFETY & INSURANCE**

Commissioner Dan Streit was not present and did not submit a report.

### **CITY ENGINEER REPORT**

City Engineer Ted Trautwein had nothing to report.

**CITY ATTORNEY REPORT**

City Attorney Stan Chauvin stated he has been working with the enforcement officer to resolve the dumpsters that had been sitting on two different properties for more than 30 days. He said the city may need to amend the dumpster ordinance. He will review that language and report back at a later date.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Mayor Coomer brought up the noise complaints that we have been receiving from a resident on Breeland Avenue. City Attorney Chauvin said he will send the enforcement officer over to investigate and possibly follow up with a letter.

Mayor Coomer asked if the audit had been completed yet. The city will need to find a new source for the audit going forward.

**BEAUTIFICATION**

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported the grass has finally been cut and dumpster removed from the house on Brownsboro Road. The branches and debris that was in the Coronado island will be removed soon.

Commissioner Longshore asked Commissioner Budniak if the sprinkler timers could be updated to just water every other day or have sensors to detect when it is raining. Commissioner Budniak said not the type that are currently installed. He will see what the cost is to replace those timers and how much water that may save the city.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mayor Coomer reported there is a downed tree behind some properties on Pipilo Court that is blocking the drainage ditch that runs behind those properties. Trees have filled in the area for some time, so the commission discussed whether or not all the trees should be removed to clear out the drainage ditch. Commissioner Longshore made a motion to have Greenscapes come remove the downed tree and clear the other trees located in the drainage ditch. Commissioner Budniak seconded. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0 (Commissioner Westerman recused himself from the vote).

Commissioner Budniak discussed an unhealthy tree at 3616 Foxglove that may need to be removed. The trees may be located in the right-of-way. City Attorney Chauvin will contact the owner.

With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Westerman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Longshore seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
