Monthly City Meeting  
Monday, January 23rd, 2023

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:02 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, Kellye Green, David Westerman, Rob Longshore, City Engineer Jon Muscutt, City Treasurer Chris Russell, and City Clerk Cory Denbo.

### **MEETING MINUTES**

The minutes from the December 19th, 2022 meeting were considered for approval. Motion by Mayor Coomer to approve the minutes as corrected. Commissioner Westerman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for December 31, 2022. City Treasurer Russell stated the balance sheet has nearly \$1.4 million. Property and insurance taxes continue to come in. These checks have been added to the general ledger. All expenses were approved at the December meeting. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Commissioner Green. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

### **WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT**

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the warrants for January 2023 (Warrant No. 1-01 to 1-08). Commissioner Longshore made a motion to pay the warrants as presented. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

### **SANITATION**

Commissioner David Westerman had nothing to report.

### **ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS**

Commissioner Robert Longshore had nothing to report. The city will be ready if and when we receive snow.

### **BEAUTIFICATION**

Commissioner Tom Budniak reported that the home / business on 3312 Barbour Lane currently has four cars in the driveway, and no garage. Over the weekend there were 5 & 6 cars there. It appears to be a medical transportation business operating out of a home within the city. Commissioner Budniak also reported that a private home between Springdale & Norton Elementary was torn down recently and appears to be a daycare

school opening up there in the near future. Concerns over traffic patterns that are already backed up were raised. The property is a commercial property and not a part of Barbourmeade.

**SAFETY & INSURANCE**

Commissioner Kellye Green on an issue at Norton Elementary parking on Sorrento & Coronado with parents dropping off children in front of homes causing safety concerns. The school has asked Barbourmeade to contact the Police Department to have some drive-by's done. The commission decided that they'd contact the Chief of Lyndon Police to have some action taken.

City Attorney Stan Chauvin was not present.
