Monthly City Meeting
Monday, April 17th, 2023

Mayor Bryan Coomer began the meeting at 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, Kellye Green, David Westerman, Rob Longshore, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Attorney Stan Chauvin and City Clerk Cory Denbo.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the March 20th, 2023 meeting were considered for approval. Motion by Commissioner Greene to approve the minutes as corrected. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for March 2023. City Treasurer Russell stated the balance sheet has nearly \$1.4 million. Property and insurance taxes continue to come in. These checks have been added to the general ledger. All expenses were approved at the March meeting. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Commissioner Westerman. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the warrants for April 2023 (Warrant No. 4-01 to 4-06). Commissioner Westerman made a motion to pay the warrants as presented. Commissioner Longshore seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no one from the public in attendance to comment.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Bryan Coomer had nothing to report.

SANITATION

Commissioner David Westerman was asked about junk day from residents. They were told that residents can do that any Monday trash is picked up just call Rumpke ahead of time to let them know.

ROADS & MAINTENANCE/ANIMALS

Commissioner Robert Longshore reported street light on Foxglove needs repair and has been submitted to LG&E. There's also a sign down on Crowntop Road that was picked up by Commissioner Longshore which will be repaired soon. He also looked at the drainage on Coronado with an issue of blockage, this was addressed by Commissioner Longshore & added to the Citywide Newsletter. There was a dog-barking complaint and the resident & Commissioner Westerman have not been able to connect yet.

BEAUTIFICATION

Commissioner Tom Budniak had nothing to report.

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Commissioner Kellye Green reported on a house watch that turned out to not be in the city. She reported a suspicious person on Foxglove that turned out to be a city resident. Directed patrol on Sorrento, Pompano, & Nandina due to speeding & illegal parking during school drop off times. LPD was on site from 0810 – 0835, no violations were given. There was radar enforcement on Barbourmeade Rd. & Barbour Lane on April 21st – 1 warning was given. House watch directed 7800 Pine Ridge Rd, all secure. Kelly reported on 2 potential security camera vendors she’s meeting with over the coming weeks.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Jon Muscutt was not present.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported that he will be pursuing delinquent taxes over the coming weeks.

OLD BUSINESS

City Attorney Stan Chauvin reported that he will be making a call to Metro Louisville about the business operating out of the City of Barbourmeade that has excessive vans in the City. Commissioner Budniak mentioned that we haven’t resolved the issue with the records pertaining to the land that we need to find the deed for.
