Monthly City Meeting
Monday, May 15, 2023

Mayor Pro Tem Rob Longshore began the meeting at 7:14 p.m. via ZOOM, as advertised on the Barbourmeade website. The following commissioners and officials were present: Mayor Bryan Coomer, Tom Budniak, Kellye Green, Rob Longshore, City Treasurer Chris Russell, City Attorney Stan Chauvin, City Engineer Jon Muscutt and City Clerk Cory Denbo.

MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the April 17th, 2023 meeting were considered for approval. Motion by Commissioner Greene to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Budniak seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the treasurer's report for April 2023. City Treasurer Russell stated the balance sheet has nearly \$1.4 million. Property and insurance taxes continue to come in. These checks have been added to the general ledger. All expenses were approved at the April meeting. Commissioner Budniak made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Commissioner Green. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

WARRANTS – BILLS FOR PAYMENT

City Treasurer Chris Russell presented the warrants for May 2023. Commissioner Green made a motion to pay the warrants as presented. Commissioner Longshore seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT

A guest speaker from Flock Security was available to speak on the capabilities of their service. Heather Lauticharoen was present & asked for help with traffic concerns on Barbourmeade Rd. to Barbour Lane during school hours. She also mentioned that there were other residents who were trying to join, but the Zoom issues we experienced during the May Meeting prevented them from joining. She mentioned wanting to have in-person meetings moving forward.
